1. Description of Project:

Focus was on decreasing Missed/Shortened treatments. Education emphasized importance of removing toxins and fluids to decrease phsyical symptoms and hospitalizations. Education was given via handouts and discussions chairside. Patients that did not miss for April and May were entered into prize drawing.

2. Outcomes Measured:

Outcomes were measured using our monthly missed or shortened treatment reports.

3. Summary of Outcomes/Results:

Missed treatments dropped from 32.2 in February before project began to 23.3 in March when education was given. In April it dropped further to 20.5% of patients missing a treatment that month. Looking at data today (5/31) Missed treatments fell to 13% for May, which is an all time low for this clinic!

4. Impact on Patients:

Education, prize incentives, and collaboration with nursing staff to reschedule missed treatments when patients miss has contributed to this significant drop in missed treatments. Due to fewer missed treatments the UFR rate and hospitalization due to fluid overload also decreased.

5. Lessons Learned:

When the interdisciplinary team comes together to educate, support, and encourage patients to complete their treatments, significant results can be achieved!

20 minutes early each treatment:

= 13 treatment per year

= One month worth of treatments!



1 treatment per week: = 52 treatments per year = 4 month of treatments!
